場 臨及聖誕期是我們教會禮儀年度的 新開始,讀經由(宣讀馬爾谷福音 為主調的)乙年轉至(恭讀路加福音為 主的)丙年讀經。不同的福音誦讀,讓 我們能從不同的角度,去認識救主耶穌 基督。

四位聖史,瑪竇(曾作稅吏的宗徒), 馬爾谷(伯多祿的書記),路加(保祿的合作者,醫生),和若望(耶穌所愛的門徒);各自從他們對耶穌基督的認識,而編寫了福音。為的是使信徒們, 能更全面地認識降生成人的天主子,我們的救主耶穌基督($I \times \Theta Y \Sigma$)。

新的時期,新的開始,就讓我們在這一年度,藉著誦讀路加福音去祈禱, 去認識主。

從以上的分享,讓我聯想到,堂區神父的調動,也有相類似的狀況。一方面,不同的神父調往不同的堂區,為團體帶來對信仰傳譯的不同幅度,或新的覺察。例如神父對於福音的講解,會因

不同的歷練,生活成長背景,靈修或牧 民取向的取捨而有所差異。多元化,多 角度地去認識信仰,有助我們的信仰生 活更為活潑;充滿生命力的信仰,有助 我們懷著平安,喜樂的心去傳佈福音的 喜訊。

另一方面,神父去到新的堂區,為 我等也是一份學習的機會,因為在新的 信仰團體中,我們能夠見證聖神的化育 工程,透過不同的信友生活的信仰的實 踐,能強化及堅定我們的牧養之心。因 聖神實在臨現在每一個你的身上;你的 參與,你的禱聲,你的付出,建立了整 個團體。

我相信,並經驗過信友們代禱的力量;有你們眾人的祈禱和對信仰的持守, 我懷著感恩的心,與你們一起在這個堂 區內,見證上主的慈愛,並為區內的居 民打開信德的大門。

「我是善牧,我認識我的羊,我的羊也認 識我。」(若10:14) 為筆者而言,用這句聖經章 節來形容書成神父,真是非常恰當。

時間飛逝,書成神父轉往天水圍聖葉理諾 堂服務轉眼已三個多月了,相信藉天主仁慈的 眷顧和帶領下,他必獲得平安與喜樂。回想起 這四年來與他的相處、共事,確是亦師亦友, 在他身上不但學會了不少信理,更令我感受到 的,就是看得見耶穌基督——我們的善牧。

回顧在慕道班一起合作時,每逢導師聚會, 討論和分享有關教理內容時,他必會非常細心 地與我們講解其要旨,需要留意之處,如何透 過分享和講授,能帶領慕道者學習信仰,認識 基督,因而皈依和轉化,這使我們首先成為再

慕道的一群,重新認清自己的信仰生活,與天 主的關係。更重要的是使我清楚了解作為慕道 班的導師,只是慕道者的同行者,帶領他們更 接近天主而已。

還記得今年五月舉辦的「善會交流日」, 當天,無論在活動時間,分享時段,不論與長 者、青年或幼童,他整天總是與教友們打成一 片,顯示出身為牧者的他,帶領團體走向共融, 彼此關顧,使堂區上下,都能真正成為基督奧 體的肢體,為天主的大愛作見證。

在此希望大家繼續為書成神父祈禱,祈求 天父時刻賜予他身心康泰,藉聖神的恩澤,成 為廣傳福音、照顧羊群的「善牧」。



本堂培育組於10月7日下午舉辦了一場有關 福傳的講座,講者為恩保德神父,當日出席者約 120人。講座開始時,恩神父引用一個很切實的 比喻,解釋福傳的意義:如教友只每星期在教堂 參與彌撒等,尤如人只不斷進食,而不出外工 作,是絕不健康的。聖保祿宗徒曾說: 「若我不 傳福音,我便有禍了。」其實,福傳確是一件簡 單易做的事,長者及小童也可擔當福傳工作,小 童藉著親情,可主動要求未領洗的父母學習道 理,而長者可透過祈禱,為福傳出一分力。

教友們的福傳,不需太關注即時的成效;福 傳的使命,只需專注播種,將工作交托上主便 只需將福傳的成果交托天主便可。 可,不用理會誰收割或何時收割,這些與福傳的

工作無關,因此福傳者不用太心急希望看到福傳 的成果。實際上,福傳的成果不是依靠人計劃的 時間,而是依賴天主的時候,天主的時刻一到, 以前所播的福傳種子便自然成事。中國人的家庭 觀念很強,亦有助教友們在家中進行福傳。

講座內容總結:

人每天吃東西,亦必須做工作配合,教友不 論老幼,在生活中需主動福傳。

福傳是簡單易做的事,任何人均可隨時實踐。

實行福傳,不需著緊福傳的即時成效,教友

主,二十年來的風風雨雨走過了,我們的手牽得更緊,求你繼續賜給我力量,做醒我,好等我做好基督徒及老公這個職份;主,亦求你繼續保守及帶領我們,因我相信,我們的婚姻是按你的旨意行事,而我們夫妻的共融結合,就正如你的聖言提及:「骨中之骨,肉中之肉」一樣!……感謝天主。
