## 信德裡沒有害怕

### The Faith that Preserve us from Fear

今天,整個世界正在面對著新型冠狀病毒危機, 這個疫症改變了無數人的生活。新型冠狀病毒本身是 前所未有的病毒,不斷地在侵襲我們的身體。這個突 發的病毒擾亂了我們的生活習慣, 迫使我們要重新編 排生活,改變工作方式和與別人溝通的渠道。這場疫 症更驅使我們對身邊的事物產生了一些奇異的眼光, 好像整個世界都變得亂七八糟的。我們四周也出現很 多人際關係破裂。新型冠狀病毒亦讓我們投射進一面 突然在我們眼前的鏡子。我們看見自己的影象倒置 了,但同時也與圍繞影象四周的空間連結起來,令人 非常不安和困惑。面對這個困難時期, 望德是最有效 用的安慰保證。無論困留在家裡的人和擔任防疫工作 的人,亦同樣需要這份保證和盼望----「我們能戰勝疫 特別在困難時刻,望德是極為有效用的力量, 我們必須保持望德, 因為復活的基督給了我們希望, 這份盼望,幫助我們在任何情況下,都能燃起生命的 亮光。

天主藉著基督的誕生奧跡對我們彰顯祂的慈愛。 在這個困難時刻,只要你用心注視,就不難發現,天 主再次給與我們機會去更新和強化與祂的關係。一個 近代的神秘主義者這樣形容:「基督的誕生是天主鍾 愛世人最偉大和最有說服力的證明。祂親自照料世 人,基督取得肉軀體,卻能與天主永久結合。基督的 降生是一份天主與人永恆訂定的愛的盟約。」 亞歷山 大的聖克萊孟 (Saint Clement of Alexandria) 這樣形容:「基督降生成人,甘願分擔人類的苦難,因為這 樣,祂才能感受到祂所愛的人的軟弱,從而使我們接 納祂的大能。」

在聖誕佳節裡,仰賴天主這份無限的仁慈和關愛,我們會互相送上聖誕祝福,亦是再次回應基督的新誡命:「如同我愛了你們,你們也該照樣彼此相愛。如果你們之間彼此相親相愛,世人因此就可認出你們是我的門徒。」(若13:34-35)基督沒有要求我們去愛祂來回應祂對我們的愛,祂只是吩咐我們效法祂去彼此相愛。換言之,基督期待我們活得像祂,就如祂曾捨棄尊威降生成人一樣,為的是要我們明白天主的愛。親愛的朋友們,天主並沒有要求我們明白發生在我們生命中的一切事,祂只要求我們不要失去信德。所以讓我們時刻信靠祂,在祂的愛內強化我們的望德。

Today, the world is facing the coronavirus crisis, a pandemic that has changed life for millions of people. The coronavirus is, in its own way, an alien and invading our bodies. It suddenly has changed the way we look at things therefore we had to reorganize our whole life, the way we work, and the way we relate with others. It also forced us to see with an unaccustomed perspective, and we saw the world turned upside down. We experience and witness many broken relationship around us. With Covid-19 we also saw ourselves projected into a mirror that suddenly opened up before us. We saw our image inverted but, at the same time, connected to all the space around it. In times like these, hope can be a powerful source of reassurance. Many who are locked at home, others who are working to help and prevent the virus, also need the reassurance and the hope that "we shall overcome this." Hope can be a powerful force, especially in difficult times. Therefore let us not give up our hope that the Risen Lord gave to us, a hope that help us to keep on burning the light of our life in all the circumstances.

During this time of turmoil once again the Lord gives us the opportunity to renew and strengthen our fellowship which is grounded in our contemplation of God's love revealed at Christmas. A contemporary mystic has written that "the birth of Christ is the greatest and most eloquent witness of how much God loved man. He loved him with a personal love. That is why he took a human body, united it to himself and made it his own forever. The birth of Christ is itself a 'covenant of love', sealed for all time between God and man". As Saint Clement of Alexandria writes, "Christ came down and assumed our humanity, willingly sharing in our human sufferings, for this reason: so that, having experienced the frailty of those whom he loves, he could then make us experience his great power".

In the light of this boundless benevolence and love, our exchange of Christmas greetings is yet another chance to respond to Christ's new commandment: "Even as I have loved you, you must also love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another" (Jn 13:34-35). Jesus does not ask us to love him in response to his love for us; rather, he asks us to love one another as he does. In other words, he asks us to become like him, since he became like us. Dear friends, in all that happens in our lives, God doesn't require us to understand rather He only asks us that not throw away our confidence in Him. Therefore let us strengthen our hope and hold on to Him at all times.

May the new born baby fill you with His love, peace and joy, Happy Christmas!



## 教區天主教墳場委員會 墳地新安排

香港龕位供不應求,港人死無葬身地的情況持續。基於天主教墳場現況:龕位短缺、墓地過剩,為此天主教教區明白教友們對墓地及龕位的需求,要有一個長遠計劃,因此教區天主教墳場委員會於2020年1月放寬加放條件及次數。

2020年9開始於柴灣聖十字墳場提供2項試驗計劃:

- 1. 可多次續期墓地:墓地共有500幅,首階段 有200幅。可容納1副棺葬遺骸骨+約48盅骨灰。( 視乎骨殖與骨灰的比例及骨箱/灰盅大小)
- 2. 可多次續期家庭龕位:家庭龕位—共1,000個,首階段240個。可容納2副骨殖箱或約9盅骨灰(視乎骨殖與骨灰的比例及骨箱/灰盅大小)。

凡加放者一定是天主教教友。加葬者必須是原葬者配偶、原葬者或其配偶父母、祖父母、外祖父母、曾祖父母、外曾祖父母、原葬者或其配偶或前述人士的胞兄弟姊妹或其配偶、或前述人士的後裔或其配偶。原葬者不可遷離該墳場,否則加葬者要一齊遷出。

使用期是首20年,其後每10年續期一次。此 實驗計劃實施5年後再作檢討。



## 發願金禧有感

### 我的家庭及聖召

我來自大部分人信奉天主教的國家---意大利,而我家庭 也是幾世代的教友。我有兩個姐姐,她們都結了婚,且有孩 子及孫兒了。

天主對我的第一次召叫是發生在我14歲時,那天有位外方傳教的神父來了我的堂區,他與我們年青人及另外一些群組,分享了他在非洲的傳教經驗。這次的接觸,令我留下一個很深刻的印象,也逐漸開啟了我對傳教生活的探索。我們這群年青人隨後組織了一個福傳組,而我們也繼續與其他傳教士保持聯絡。18歲那年,在我往訪指導神師時,很驚訝地他突然問我有沒有想過加入聖母無原罪傳教女修會!因他知道我有積極參與由年青人所成立的傳教小組活動。

他給我的提問,彷如一股強大的光,照亮了我的腦袋。 我頓時感覺好像是天主給我的召叫。當我漫步回家時,我察 覺到我心跳加速;而腦海中不斷地盤旋著他的問題,同時我 也發覺到自己的眼睛充滿著淚水,但內心卻充滿著深深的平 安和喜悅。在沒有任何的猶豫下,我對天主的召叫說了「我 願意」,跟著我就盤算如何向家人道出我的決定。


一天,當我發覺母親獨自在做刺繡工作時,我鼓起勇氣告訴她我的決定---我渴望加入修道院,作一個外方傳教修女。她當時盡力勸阻我,並勸說我太年輕,建議我再多等幾年才作這個決定。當時我接受了她的規勸,而沒有再提及此事。約一年後,我再次向母親商議,由於她感受到我的決心,就不再堅持。就這樣,我在1967年9月11日乘坐了由羅馬開出到米蘭的火車,開展我的新生命!

我在發初願後,就被安排到另一個團體繼續我的學業。 這給予我機會接觸到其他人及面對不同的處境,讓我能建立 關係及認識到現實的世界,對我來說會是一項嶄新的經驗。 事關在選擇「貧窮、貞潔及服從」的修道生活,竟是與世俗 追隨的價值觀有著截然不同的觀點。這段學習與適應期間, 給予我一些新的體會,令我會更深入探討自己的聖召回應。

四年後,當我第一次回家時,我的姐姐對我說「如果你想回家,我們是很歡迎你回來的。」我內心感到有一種掙扎,我覺得天主好像再一次邀請我回覆,但要我在一個絕對自由和成熟的思想下,更深度地對天主說出「我願意」。慶幸在天主的恩寵下,透過祈禱和團體給我的支持,我最後可在充滿喜悅和堅定的心,再次向天主說出「我願意」!

### 蒞臨香港

我被委派來香港其實是意料之外,因為我所接觸過的傳教士,他們大部分都是被派遣到其他地方,如印度,中國,非洲,孟加拉等地,而這些地方與香港的環境非常不同,自然地我也以為自己會被派遣到這些地方。所以當我知道要來香港時,其實我第一個反應並非太熱衷,不過我仍然很歡迎這個派遣,因為我深信這是天主給我最好的安排,到一個恰



向我的家人和家鄉道別,是一件很抽心的事,但當我想到我可以滿全天主給我廣傳祂的「愛」和「福音」喜訊的計劃時,那種喜悅就蓋過一切離別的思緒。還記得母親當時眼泛淚光地給我臨別贈言:「媽媽內心感到平安和喜樂,因為我看見你帶著很歡欣的心情,準備到香港,一個天主給你安排的地方,為這地方的人服務。」我當時非常感動。這亦是我們最後的一次會面,因為母親在幾年後就回歸天主的懷抱。

### 與主相遇

大概兩年前,當時我還是工作纏身;跟進傳道員的工作、準備慕道者和兒童的聖洗聖事、安排避静、與慕道者個別見面及與家長見面等等,突然我有一種感覺---是身體上出現了問題。但當時因手頭上還有很多工作要處理,無暇理會,直至二月底我去了聖德肋撒醫院,做了全身的電腦掃描及磁力共震,結果顯示出我身體有嚴重的狀況……胰臟癌!真是晴天霹靂!

我第一個反應是問天主:「為何祢第二次考驗我?」當我慢慢反省保祿宗徒致羅馬人書時,特別是我喜愛的第8章28節:「而且我們也知道,天主使一切協助那些愛祂的人,就是那些按祂的旨意蒙召的人,獲得益處。」我恍然得到啟悟了!

是的,天主給我的計劃或許我不太明白,但我相信一定 有祂的目的和會達至最好的結果。所以,我將自己完全降服 給天主,安詳地躺在祂的臂彎內及欣然接受一切情況。這個 心境使我不會過度憂慮,反而能全心、全意、全靈地信靠天 主,及那些悉心照顧我的醫生、護士和朋友。

誠然,天主真的送我很多愛我的天使來照顧我,我實在衷心感激!

這個經歷,也讓我明白天主想我學習「放下」。因我一向都是希望能事事掌握,無論是我的生命或是我的工作。 現在,我要學懂讓天主來掌管。天主要求我與祂建立一個更深度的關係,也要求我在每一刻都能找到祂的臨在,無論事情大小,無論生命中的喜樂和痛苦,我要認識祂對我那偉大的、無條件的和忠貞的愛。

#### 給我的堂區教友

親愛的兄弟姊妹,在我們人生旅途中的不同階段,天主的愛會很含隱地陪伴着我們。天主會默默地用祂的耐心和慈悲帶領著我們,讓我們打開自己的心扉,迎接祂那無限的愛情,然後將這愛分施給所有兄弟姊妹,特別是那些仍未認識天主的他們。

#### My family and vocation

I am from Italy, and in Italy the majority of people are catholic. Also my family received Catholic faith many generations ago. I have two elder sisters who are married with children and gran children.

There was an event that led to my vocation: when I was 14 a PIME Missionary priest came to my parish to share his missionary experience in Africa with us the youth and other groups. He made a deep impression on me. This event opened my mind gradually to missionary life. The youth formed a missionary group and we continued to be in touch with other missionaries. At the age of 18 I went to see my spiritual director and to my great surprise he asked me: "Have you ever thought of joining the Missionary Sisters of the Immaculate – the PIME Sisters?" He knew of my active participation in the missionary group.

His question was like a powerful light enlightening my mind, I felt as if God asked me that question. As I walked back home, I felt my heart beat fast, my mind pondering over the question put to me, my eyes with tears and within me a deep peace and joy. Without hesitation, I said "Yes" to the Lord's call. Next step was how to tell it to my family. One day as I found my mother alone stitching, I took courage and told her my secret: I wanted to join the convent to be a missionary. She tried to dissuade me telling that I was too young, it would be better to wait few more years. For the time being I had to accept her decision and spoke no more about it. About a year later I approached my mother once again... she saw that I was firm in my decision, she let me go. So on 11th of September 1967, I boarded the train from Rome and went to Milan to start my new life.

#### **Experience during vocation journey**

In my new life, undoubtedly there were difficulties and challenges during the formation: the community life-style totally different from the previous one and the convent discipline, calling me for a continuous change. But they turned out to be opportunities to rid my heart and mind of all attachments, keeping my focus on just one thing: to journey on to follow the Lord with all my heart and offer my life totally to Him in this religious missionary Family.

After my first profession I was assigned to another community to continue my studies, This gave me opportunities to interact with different people and situations, build up relationships and be in touch with the reality of the world. This experience was another challenge for my choice of poverty, chastity and obedience, totally opposed to the values of the world. Temptations were not lacking, casting doubts and questioning my vocation. After four years, when I went home for the first time, my sister told me: "if you want to come back, we are very happy to have you back at home." There was an inner struggle in me. I felt as if God were asking me again, to say my yes to Him, with total freedom, in a mature and deeper way. And God's grace did not fail me: with His grace, prayer and the help of the community, I was able to say my "Yes" for a second time joyfully and with a resolute heart.

#### **Coming to Hong Kong**

My coming to Hong Kong was quite unexpected because majority of the missionaries I met and listened to were from other contexts: India, China, Africa, Bangladesh, places very different from Hong Kong. So naturally I was thinking along these lines to spend my missionary



life. As such, my first reaction when I was assigned to HK, was not so enthusiastic, normal to each one of us to feel so when we are sent. However, I welcomed it because I was sure that God had decided it for me and it was the right place and people to whom to dedicate my missionary life and service. In this assurance I found great peace and joy that led me to be interested in the HK mission and prepare myself for the departure.

To say goodbye to my family and my hometown was quite demanding but the desire and joy of fulfilling God's plan for me to proclaim His love and the Gospel to those who do not know Him overrode this difficulty. I was deeply touched and still remember my Mother's words at my departure, though she was in tears: "I feel peace and joy in my heart because I see you very happy to go to Hong Kong, to the people whom God is sending you." This was our last meeting because she left for heaven after a couple of years.

#### **Encounter with the Lord**

About two years ago, I was busily engaged: following up the catechists, preparation of the catechumens and children for the baptism; retreat, meeting them personally, parents' meeting etc. I felt that something was wrong with my health. But with several things on hand I had little time to think of it. Only towards the end of February I went to St. Teresa's Hospital for a check-up. A complete body CT scan and MRI showed something serious: I had pancreatic cancer - this was a terrible blow to me. My first reaction was to ask God: 'why are you asking me this for a second time?' Slowly reflecting over it, a passage very dear to me from St. Paul's letter to the Romans shed light on this. "We are well assured that everything turns out to be for the good of those whom God loves" (Rm 8: 28). Yes, truly God has a plan for me which I hardly understand but I believe that it will result in something good. Thereafter I surrendered myself totally and peacefully in God's arms, accepting whatever would come on my way. This disposition enabled me not to worry too much, but to trust in God and in those, doctors, nurses, friends that would take care of me. Truly God sent many angels who cared for me with great love. I am very, very grateful to them.

This experience led me to understand that God was asking me to let go of my wanting to keep control over everything: my life, my work and instead, allow Him to be in control. He was calling me to grow in a deeper relationship with Him; to discover His presence in the 'NOW' that is: in every event- small or great, joyful or painful that happens in my life, recognizing in them His great, unconditional and faithful love for me.

#### Share with the parishioners
